CHRISTMAS TREE



Your Live Christmas tree will bring you years of pleasure if you follow these simple steps:

- 1.) Determine the planting location for the tree and dig the hole early in the month while the ground is still workable. The hole should be twice as wide as the root ball but **no deeper**.
- 2.) Before bringing your tree indoors, it must be acclimated in an unheated room, such as a garage, for a **minimum of 2 to 3 days**. This allows your tree to SLOWLY adjust to warmer temperatures.
- 3.) As Christmas nears, bring your tree indoors. Keep it inside for **10 days or less for best results**. Keep it in a tub for ease of handling & watering. Water as needed to **keep ball moist**. **AVOID STANDING WATER**.

After Christmas, **store your tree in an unheated room again**, so it can adjust to cooler temperatures. Store for a minimum of 2 to 3 days. After an adjustment period, your tree **must be planted in the ground**. Place the tree in the prepared hole. Backfill with native soil and any other soils amendments.
