

Plants and their Browse Risk

The following is a list of plants have low, moderate, and high risk of being browsed by deer. It must be stated though: **hungry deer will eat *anything*** if they must. Help us improve this list by sharing your experiences of deer browsing with Bristol's Garden Center staff.

Note: Most small (young or dwarf) trees are still susceptible to Buck Rub during the cooler months (November – March). In areas with high deer populations, protection of small trees is necessary.
