Viburnums

Viburnums are fantastic shrubs that serve a multitude of purposes from hedging to ornamental gardens. They act as habitats and provide meals for birds while also attracting pollinators from all over. These highly deer- and rabbit-resistant, flowering shrubs vary in size and flower color. Although there are many Viburnums listed below, not all of them are currently stocked. Ask nursery staff for more details.

Mohawk Viburnum	<i>Viburnum x</i>	7-8'	7-8'	Red buds open to very fragrant white flowers. April - May.	Purple-black	Orange-red to red-purple	N	Abundant flowerer. Does best in full to part sun.
Korean Spice Viburnum	<i>Viburnum carlesii</i>	5-7'	4-6'	Pink-red buds open to white, semi-snowball flowers. April-May.	Red - Black	Wine Red	N	Beautiful fragrance. Full Sun to partial shade. Best in well-drained soils.
Dwarf Korean Spice Viburnum	<i>Viburnum carlesii 'Compactum'</i>	3-4'	3-4'	Pink-red buds open to white, semi-snowball flowers. April-May.	Red - Black	Wine Red	N	Dwarf selection. Sun to partial shade.
Cayuga Viburnum	<i>Viburnum xcarlcephalum 'Cayuga'</i>	5-8'	4-6'	Pink buds open to fragrant white flowers. April - May.	Red - Black	Orange - Red	N	Full to partial sun. Well-drained soil. Tight growing plant.
Witherod Viburnum	<i>Viburnum cassinoides</i>	6-10'	4-6'	Flowers are creamy white. Appear in June-July.	Pink to Red to blue	Orange-Red	Y	Full Sun to partial shade. Glossy, dark green leaves. Nice compact, rounded structure.
Arrowwood Viburnum	<i>Viburnum dentatum</i>	6-10'	6-8'	Creamy white flowers appear around June.	Red to blue-purple	Red	Y	Sun to shade. Extremely adaptable to a variety of soil and light conditions.

'Cardinal Candy' Linden Viburnum	<i>Viburnum dilatatum</i>	4-6'	4-6'	Creamy white flowers appear May - June.	Red	Red	N	Sun to partial shade. Heavy fruiting.
European Snowball Viburnum (Cranberrybush)	<i>Viburnum opulus</i>	8-10'	8-10'	Large, White, round flowers. May - June.	Red	Red - Burgundy	N	Sun to partial sun. Adaptable in terms of soil tolerant poor, dry, or moist conditions.
'Mariesii' Double File Viburnum	<i>Viburnum plicatum f.tomentosum</i>	10-12'	10-12'	Flat white flowers. May - June	Red turning to black	Red - Burgundy	N	Excellent specimen plant. Beautiful horizontal branching structure. Flowers best in full sun.
'Shasta' Double File Viburnum	<i>Viburnum plicatum f. tomentosum</i>	6'-8'	10-12'	Flat white flowers.	Red turning to black	Red - Burgundy	N	Excellent specimen plant. Beautiful horizontal branching structure. Flowers best in full sun.
'Summer Snowflake' Viburnum	<i>Viburnum plicatum f. tomentosum</i>	10-12'	6-8'	Flat white flowers. May - November	Red turning to black	Red - Burgundy	N	Smaller flowers, fruit, and leaves than other <i>V.plicatum</i> . One major bloom in spring, then continuing sporadically till November.
Blackhaw Viburbum	<i>Viburnum prunifolium</i>	10-12'	8-10'	Creamy, white. Late April - May	Pinkish turning to a blue	Shiny Red	Y	One of the most adaptable Viburnums. Great for hedging. Sun - Shade
'Alleghany' Leather Leaf Viburnum	<i>Viburnum xrhynchophylloides</i>	8-10'	8-10'	Creamy white, flat. May.	Red changing to black	Purple	N	Semi-evergreen. Great for screens or borders. Sun - part. Best in protected locations.
'Pragense' Viburnum	<i>Viburnum 'Pragense'</i>	8-10'	6-8'	Pink in bud, opening to creamy white, fragrant. May.	Red changing to black	None (semi-evergreen)	N	Beautiful selection. Fast growing. Great for screens. Semi-evergreen. Best in protected locations.
American Cranberry Viburnum	<i>Viburnum trilobum</i>	8-10'	8-10'	Creamy white, round flowers. May.	Bright Red (edible, great for jellies)	Red-Purple	Y	Sun to Part Shade. Fairly adaptable.
