Weigela (pronounced *why-JEE-luh*) are small, cold hardy flowering shrubs native to eastern Asia. Over time, they have been cultivated to have a variety of flower and foliage colors. They are easy to grow, requiring **well-drained soils with a pH range between 5.5 and 7.5 in full sunlight**. As a showy, ornamental shrub, weigela make a great addition to any sunny garden as an accent or centerpiece!
